Supply List... for ten days of focusing little (& big) hearts and minds on Him.

Please don't get bogged down by this list! It looks long because it's an exhaustive list if you did every single activity for each day, but mostly everything can be found in your art supply cabinet or pantry (& with some recycled or dollar store plastic Easter eggs). And almost everything (with the exception of the baking supplies on day 7) is interchangeable. If you don't have one of the suggested items- get creative and find something you already have in your home. So, if you don't have a gold Easter egg, use a yellow one... if you don't have a jar, use a vase... if you don't have grape juice, use purple water, etc. Use it as a guide for making your Easter about Jesus.

And, if you don't have time for all of the activities, that's just fine!! The goal is to lead our kids to Jesus by helping them get to know the Good News! ©

Every day you will need a Bible, Bible Storybook, and/or a way to listen to episodes from The Kidz Audio Bible.

<u>The Triumphant Entry – Day 1</u>

{Palm Sunday}

pillow/person (for a donkey) palm branches -orgreen paper, stick, & tape basket grass, leaves, or Easter grass

Anointed With the Heart - Day 2

small jar watered down glue -or- mod podge colorful tissue paper -or- cellophane ribbon gold Easter egg money

Christ's Example to Serve – Day 3

dirt water towel blue Easter egg small bar of soap -or- washcloth *Extra: craft sticks & markers

<u>The Last Supper – Day 4</u>

bread -or- crackers grape juice purple Easter egg breadcrumb -or- cracker *Extra: for stained glass crosses... crayon shavings, wax paper, iron, newspaper -or- for giant stained glass cross... colorful cellophane, dish soap, water

<u>Prayer in the Garden – Day 5</u>

aluminum foil griddle crayons colorful Easter egg jellybeans (or other colorful treat)

<u>The Sacrifice – Day 6</u>

20-30 rocks marker

Buried in the Tomb – Day 7

l cup pecans l tsp. vinegar 3 egg whites pinch of salt l cup sugar Ziploc baggie wooden spoon wax paper cookie sheet tape red cloth *Extra- yarn

<u>He is Risen! – Day 8</u> {Resurrection Sunday}

Any items you'd like to display <u>Christ at the heart of your Easter celebration</u> (we like using this <u>Easter Scavenger Hunt</u> each year)! optional - silver Easter egg

red (permanent) marker red Easter egg nail
